KARL STIRNER ARTS TRAIL CLEAN UP DAY SATURDAY, APRIL 28, 2018

Instructions and Safety Information

- The portion of the trail targeted for clean up today is from the Blue Bridge off of Bushkill Drive westward to N. 13th Street.
- Clean up supplies (gloves, garbage bags) will be available at the Blue Bridge over the Bushkill Creek and at the 13th Street trailhead.
- Place small items in garbage bags and drag bags to the side of the paved trail when full. The City will pick up all bags on Monday.
- Drag larger items (tires, tree limbs, etc.) to the side of the paved trail. The City will also pick up these items on Monday.
- Several City staff members may be cutting dead tree limbs using power equipment (chainsaws, etc.). Volunteers may drag cut limbs, branches, brush, etc. to the side of the trail after its been cut, but everyone should **use extreme caution** when power equipment is in use. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES** should anyone other than City staff operate any power equipment during the Clean Up.
- Volunteers should only access areas along the trail that they feel comfortable accessing and should do so at their own risk. There are places along the trail that are very steep and caution should be taken if you choose to access any of these areas.
- First aid kits will be located at the Blue Bridge and at the 13th Street entrance.

Parking is available at the KSAT lot at 500 Bushkill Drive or at the 13th Street trailhead lot.
